- Children must not use the play equipment on collection or drop off as it is disinfected between bubbles using it.

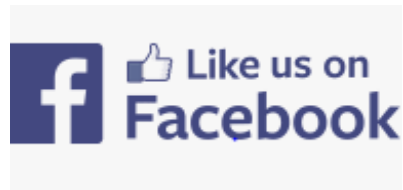
