

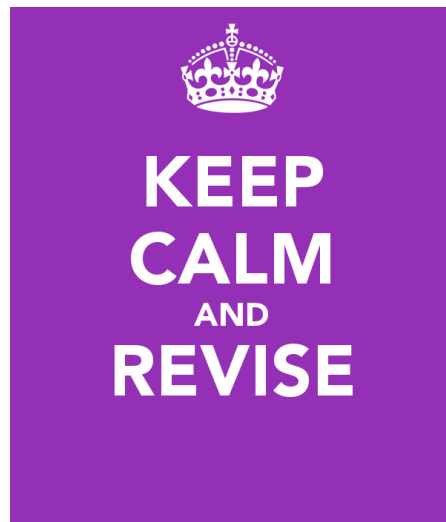


Revision – Student Tips

- Make a revision timetable to avoid wasting precious revision time. Think carefully about the times of day when you concentrate best (put more difficult topics in these time slots).
- Block out times when you have regular commitments (e.g. sports clubs, paper round etc.). Be mindful that while paid employment is great for resilience and confidence during Year 11 it is not a good idea. Let's face it, you have the rest of your working life ahead of you!
- List all your examination subjects and the amount of time that you think you will need for each one. It is unlikely that the amounts will be equal. Many students find they need to allocate more time to subjects or topics they find the most difficult.
- Plan in time off, include time for activities which can be done in the fresh air. You should take a 10-minute break every 25 minutes. Ensure you drink plenty of fluids.
- Participating in stress relieving activities – exercise, reading, watching a movie is equally as important as the revision itself.
- You may find it helpful to change from one subject to another at 'break' time, for example doing one or two sessions of English and then changing to Geography or alternating a favourite subject with a more difficult one. It helps to build in some variety.
- Write up your plan and display it somewhere visible e.g. the fridge in the kitchen and your bedroom.
- Make sure you eat healthily - especially the superfoods which aid and support memory as well as drinking water at regular intervals.
- Make sure you have good sleep patterns and minimise ICT (phones, tablets, computers in your bedroom).



- Adjust your timetable if necessary, in order to focus on the weakest topics and subjects.
- Create a suitable revision space, a quiet place with a table where disturbances will be kept to a minimum. It is not a good idea to revise in front of the TV. Remove distractions such as mobile phones and Facebook.
- Ensure you have all the equipment you need e.g. highlighters, coloured pens, Post-It notes etc.
- Positive thinking is important! There will be times when you are not in the mood or it is just not sticking. Don't panic! Take a break and try to only think about one task at a time rather than everything at once.
