We have a House System which is designed to fully support all learners throughout their time at the academy. House Leaders, Pastoral Support Assistants and Mentors support our young people so that they have the best possible learning experiences, and they work with both students and parents to ensure any barriers to learning are overcome.

Learners are represented by the College Council which consists of representatives from every mentor group. This is led by House Leaders alongside our very own Student Leadership Team who also meet regularly with senior staff to consult on areas of strength and development.

An Inspirational Environment

We are extremely proud of the recent and significant investment we have secured for the academy with support from the Local Authority. In September 2019, the college was redesignated to become a 2-19 all-through academy with the addition of a brand new, two form entry primary phase school.

More recently we have undertaken a major development of the secondary site to provide an additional teaching block with 22 new classrooms as well as a second, floodlit all-weather sports facility.

We want all of our learners to aspire to achieve great things. We are proud to have developed links with a range of guest speakers and alongside our high quality careers programme, we are able to deliver excellent advice and guidance.

In addition to extra-curricular activities, we believe that learning outside of the classroom is crucial in bringing learning to life whilst helping students to raise their own aspirations.

We have great opportunities for learners to experience life beyond the classroom; within work experience settings, through a wide range of educational visits and journeys, and exciting activities which all aim to broaden learner experiences and cultural knowledge.







Curriculum

At Hailsham Community College all-through academy, we have an ambitious and coherent curriculum that ensures learners engage in broad and rich experiences, preparing them for the next stage in their education, employment and adult life.

Our curriculum will:
